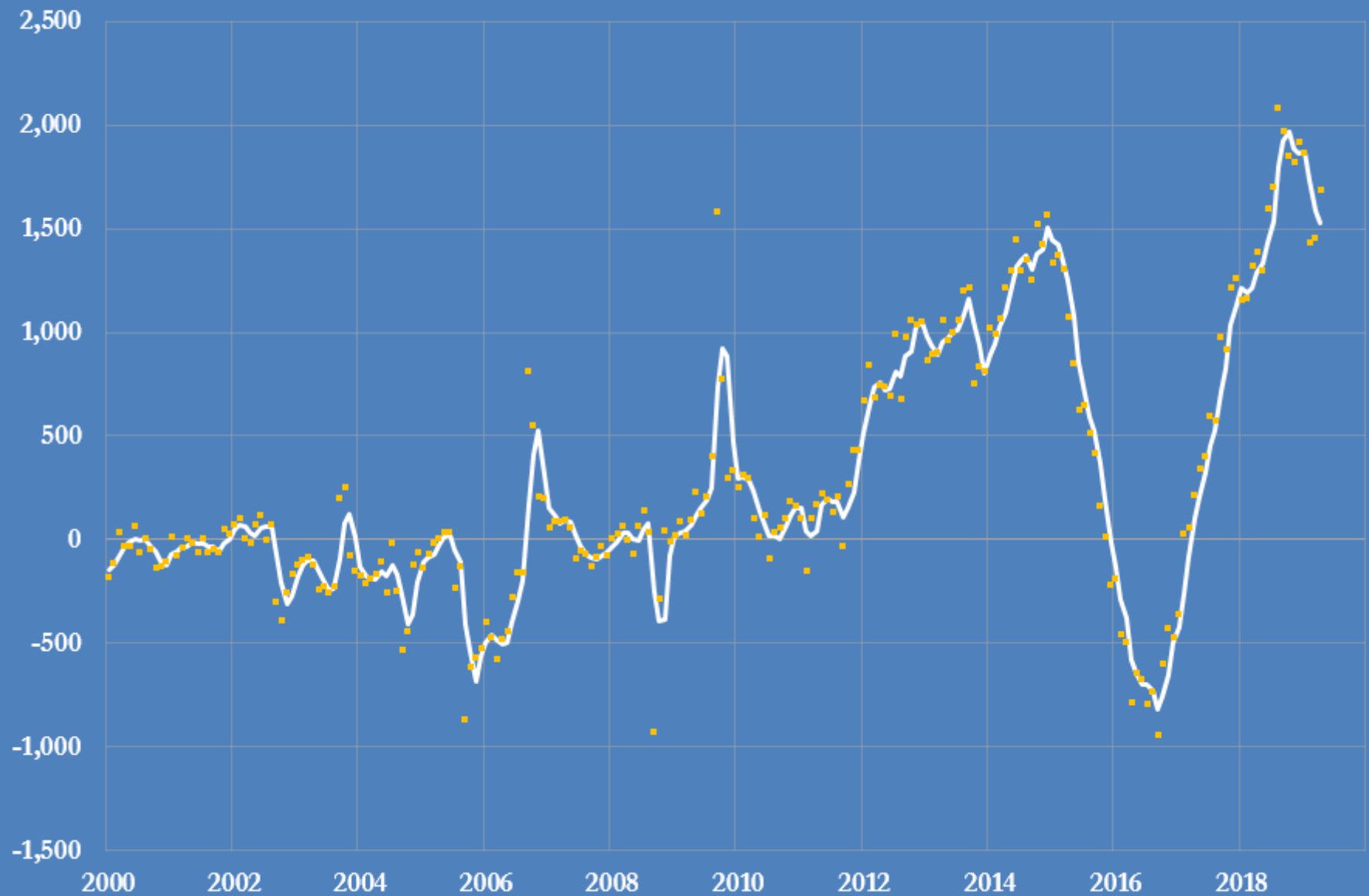

Increase compared with prior year, monthly and 3-month average, 000 b/d

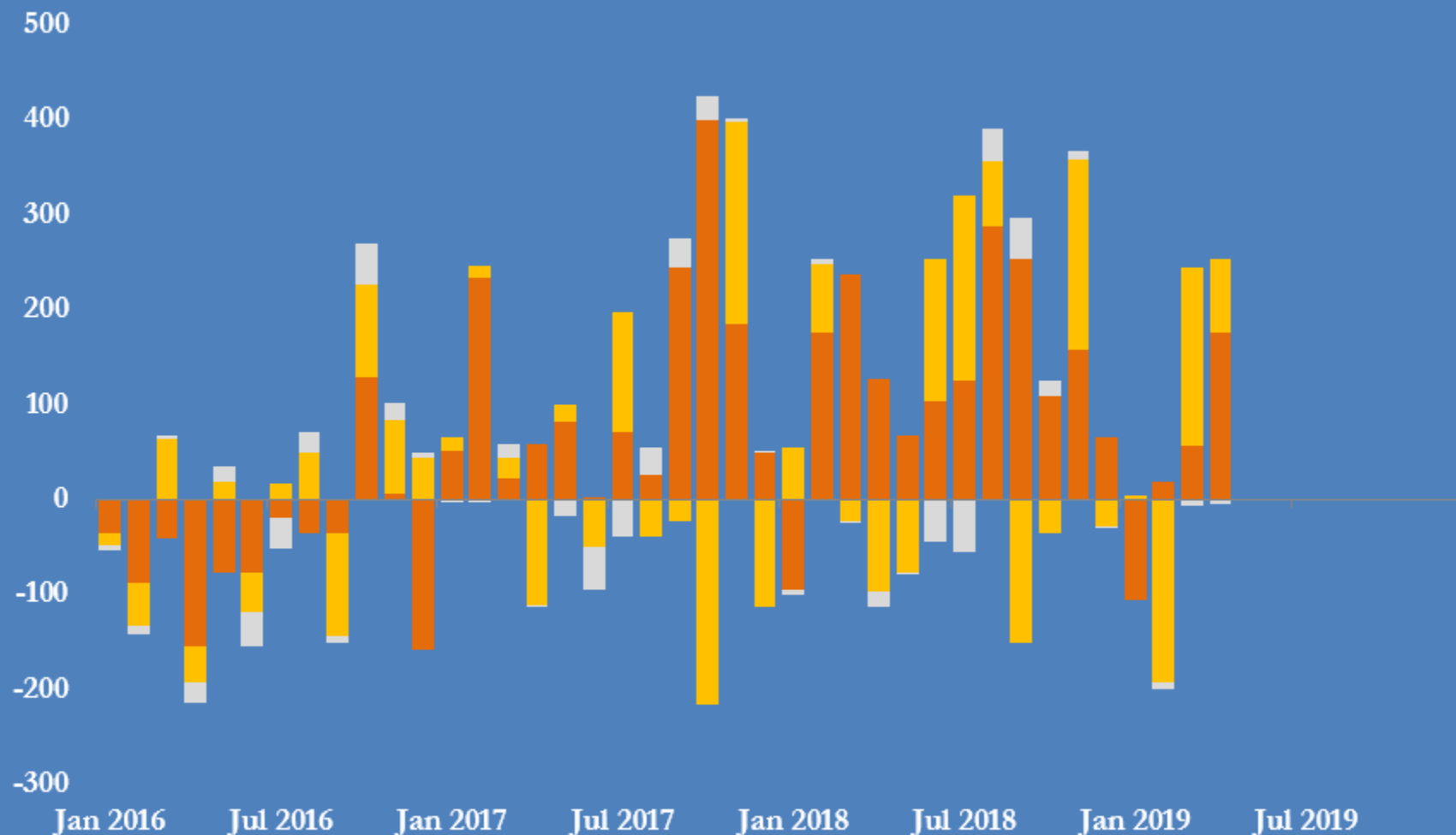

Monthly change in 000 b/d

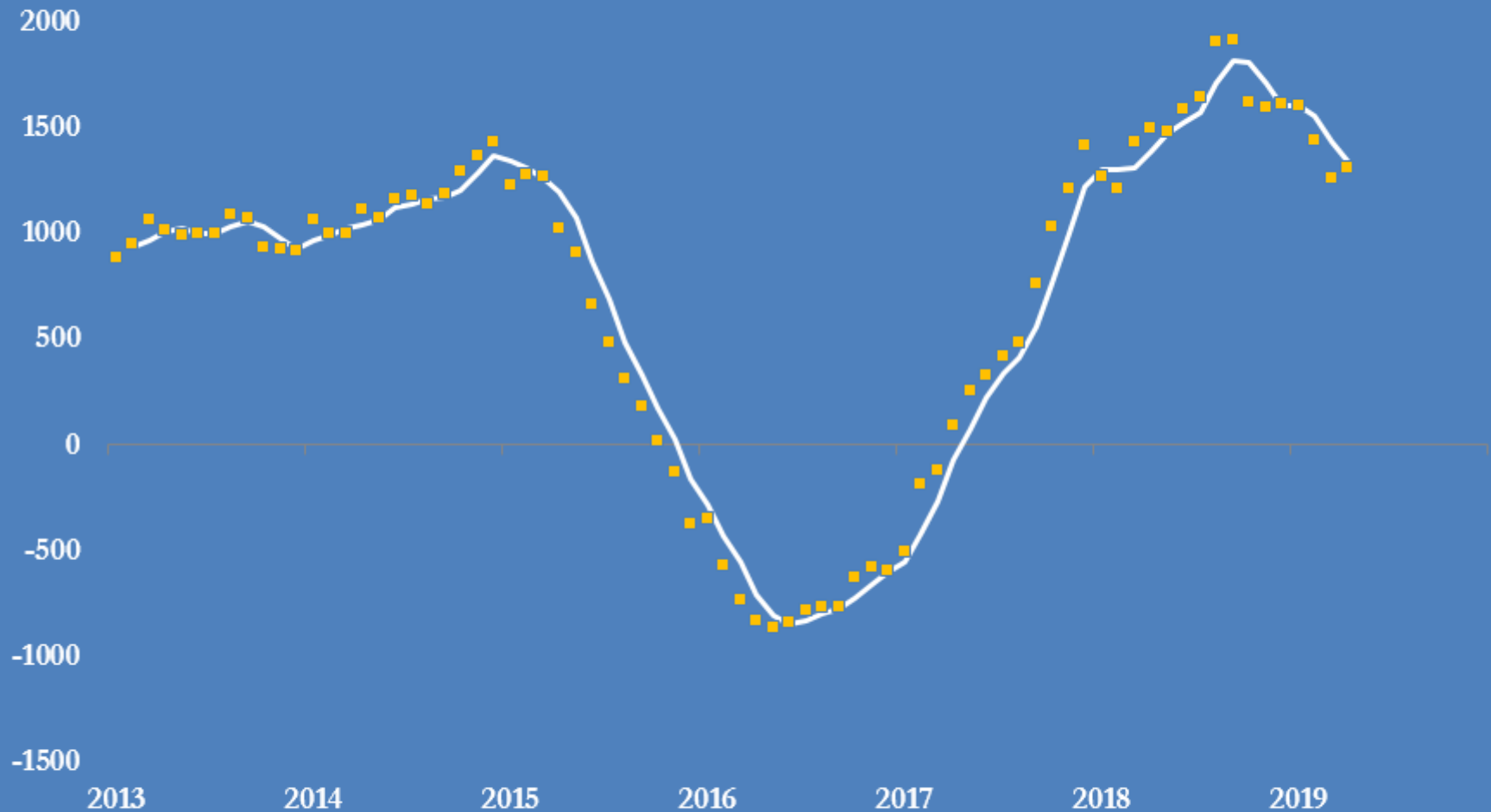

Increase compared with prior year, monthly and 3-month average

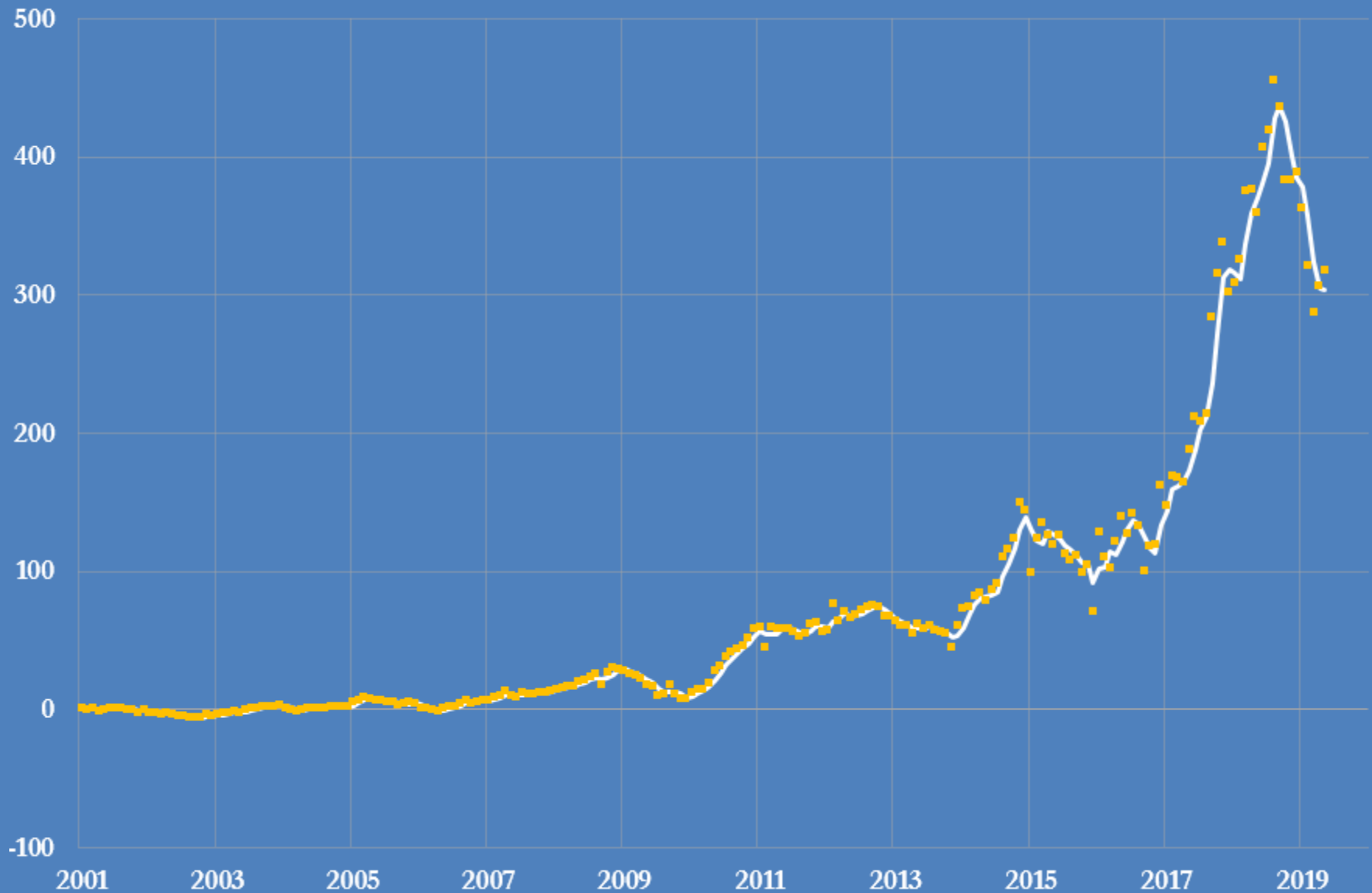

Change from prior year, 000 b/d, monthly and three-month average

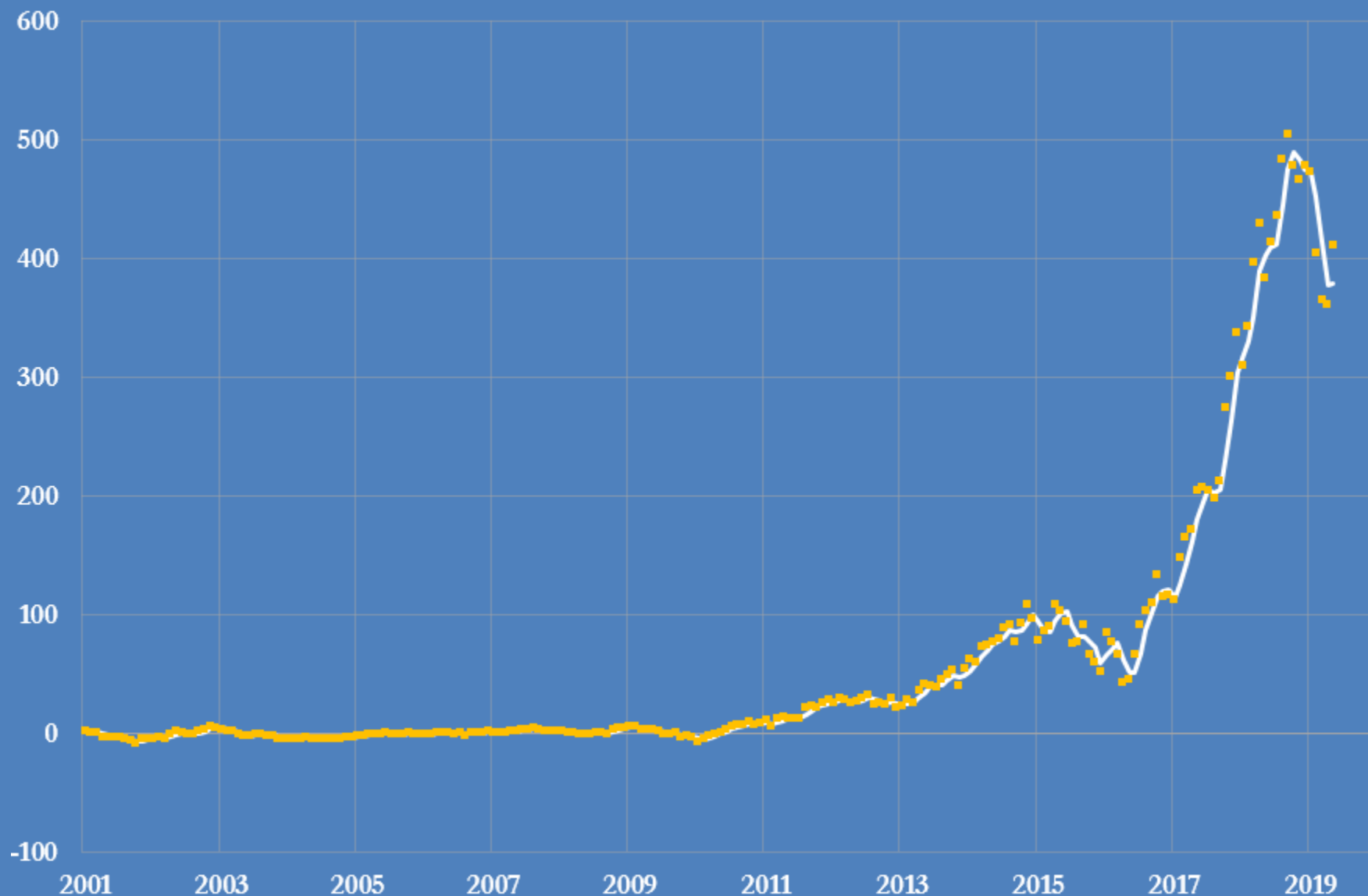

Change from prior year, 000 b/d, monthly and three-month average

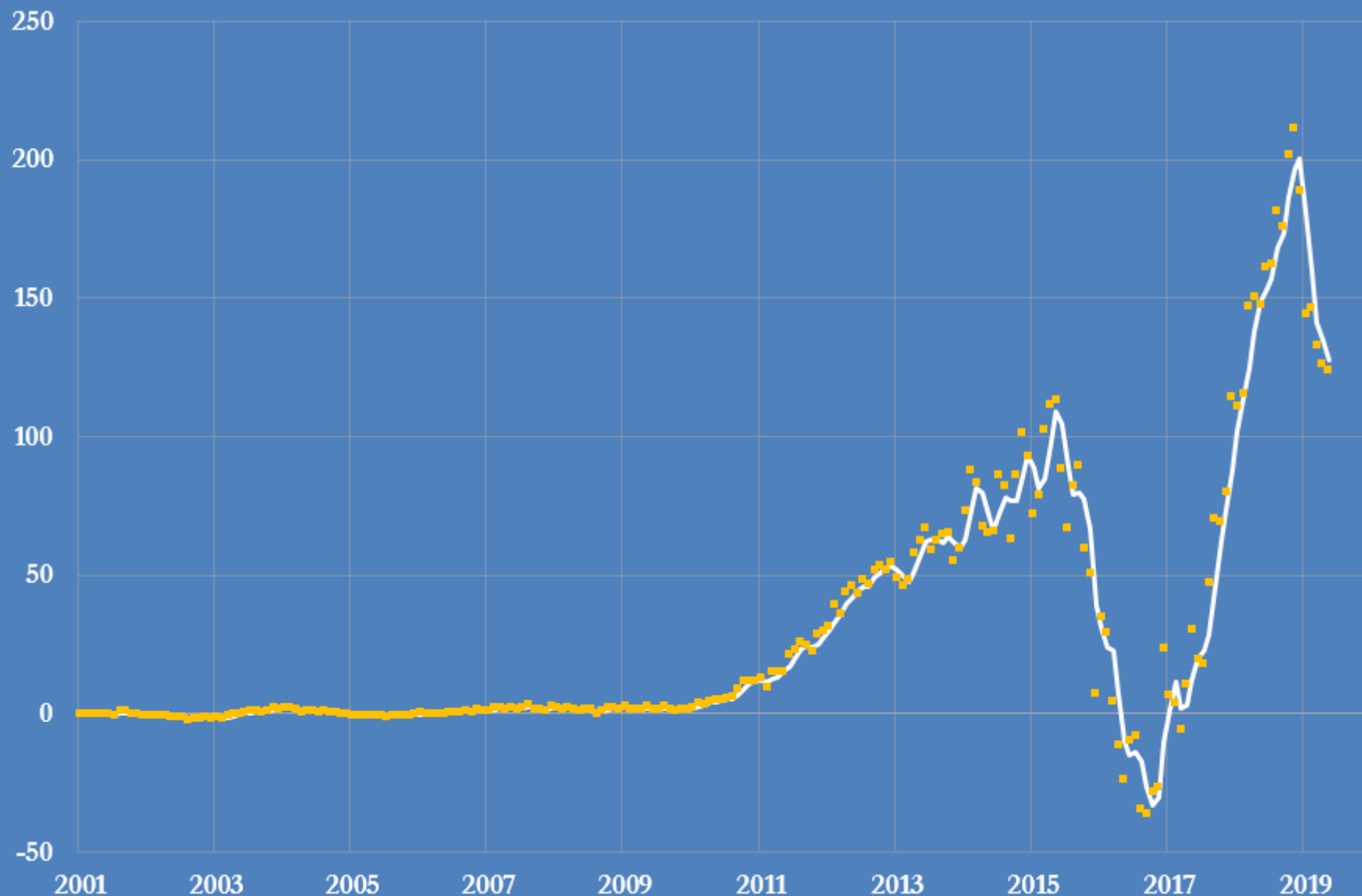

Change from prior year, 000 b/d, monthly and three-month average

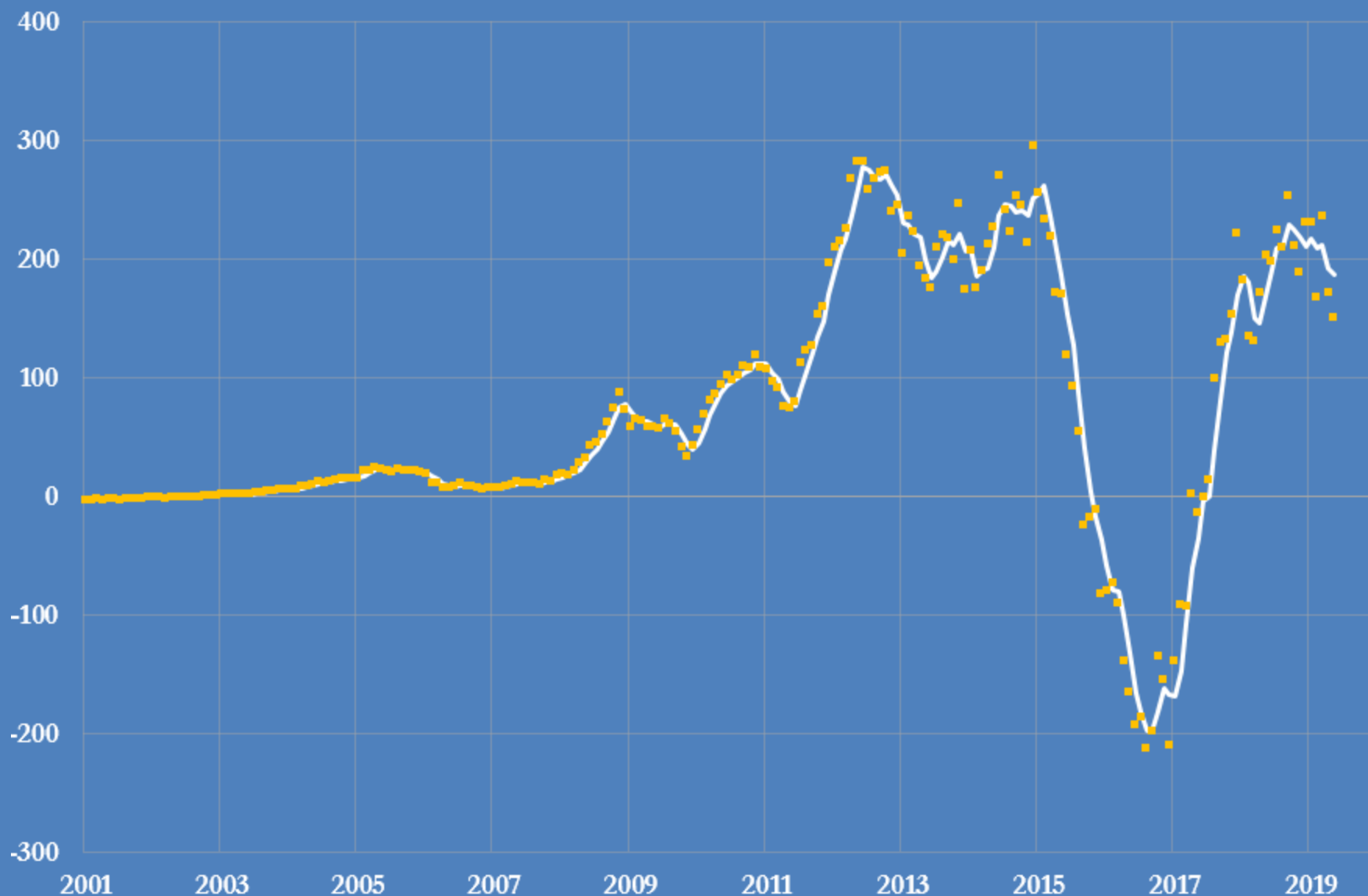

Change from prior year, 000 b/d, monthly and three-month average

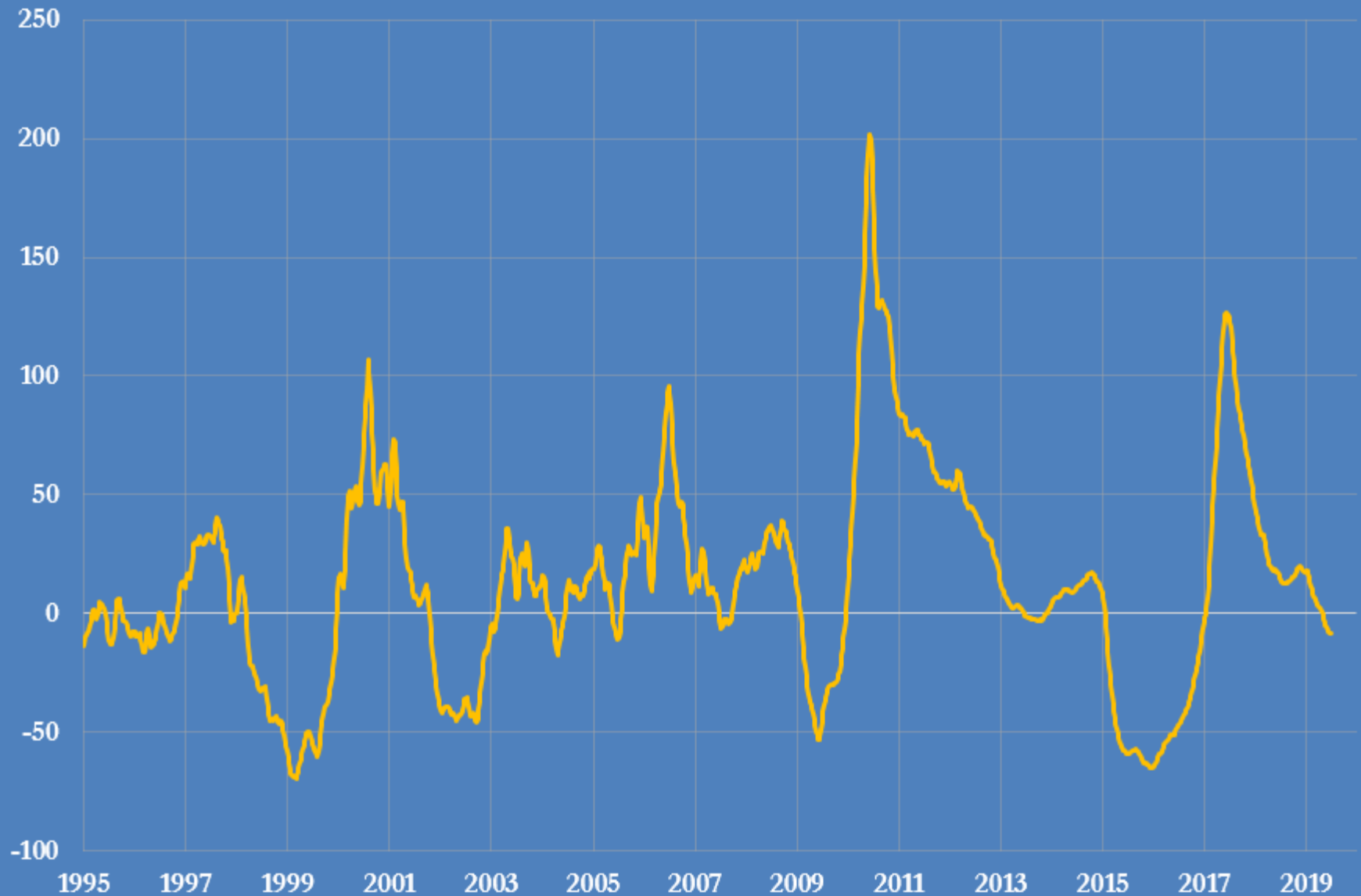

U.S. rigs actively drilling for oil, 1995-2019

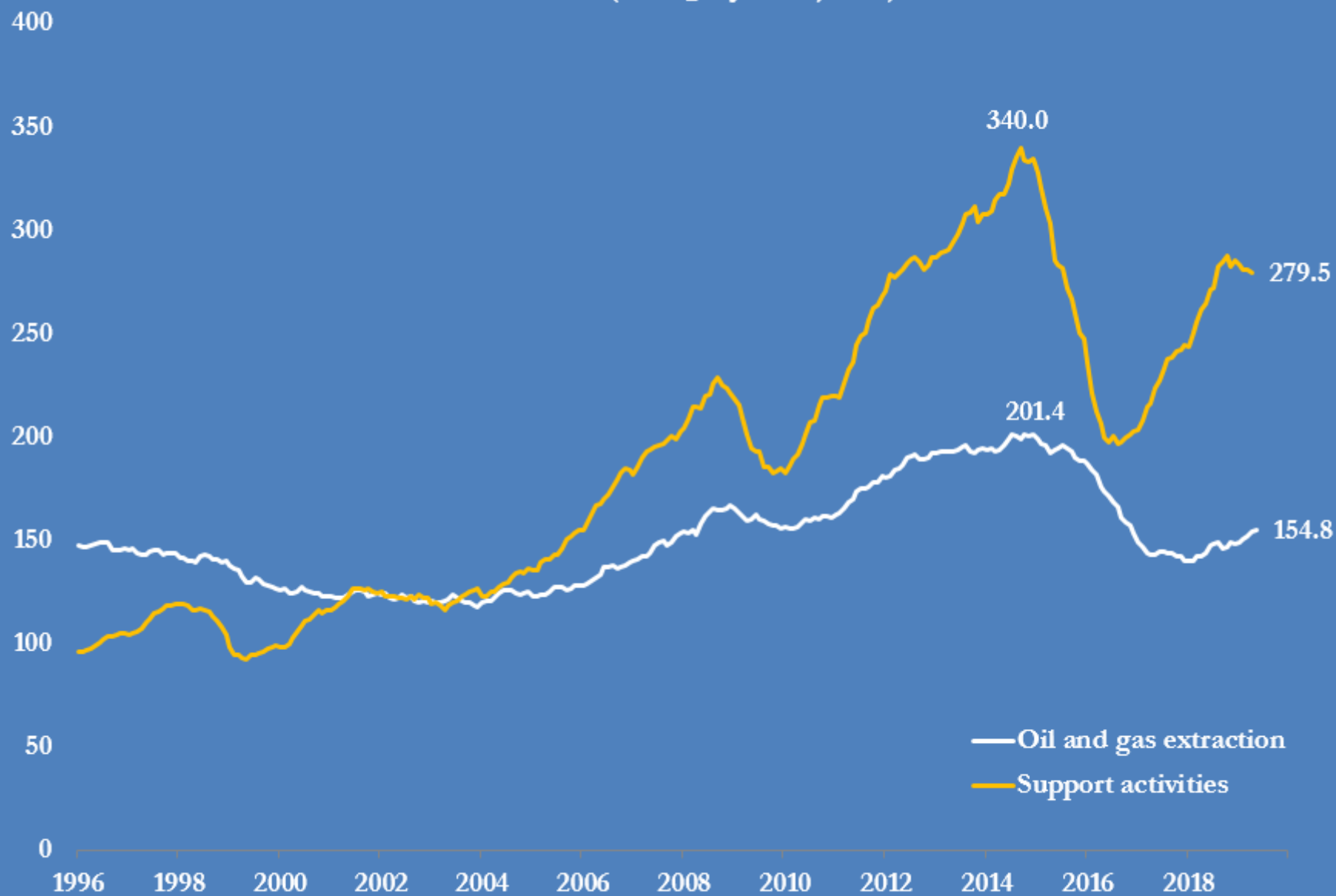
Percent change compared with prior year, four-week average

U.S. employment in oil and gas extraction and support activities (000 payroll jobs)

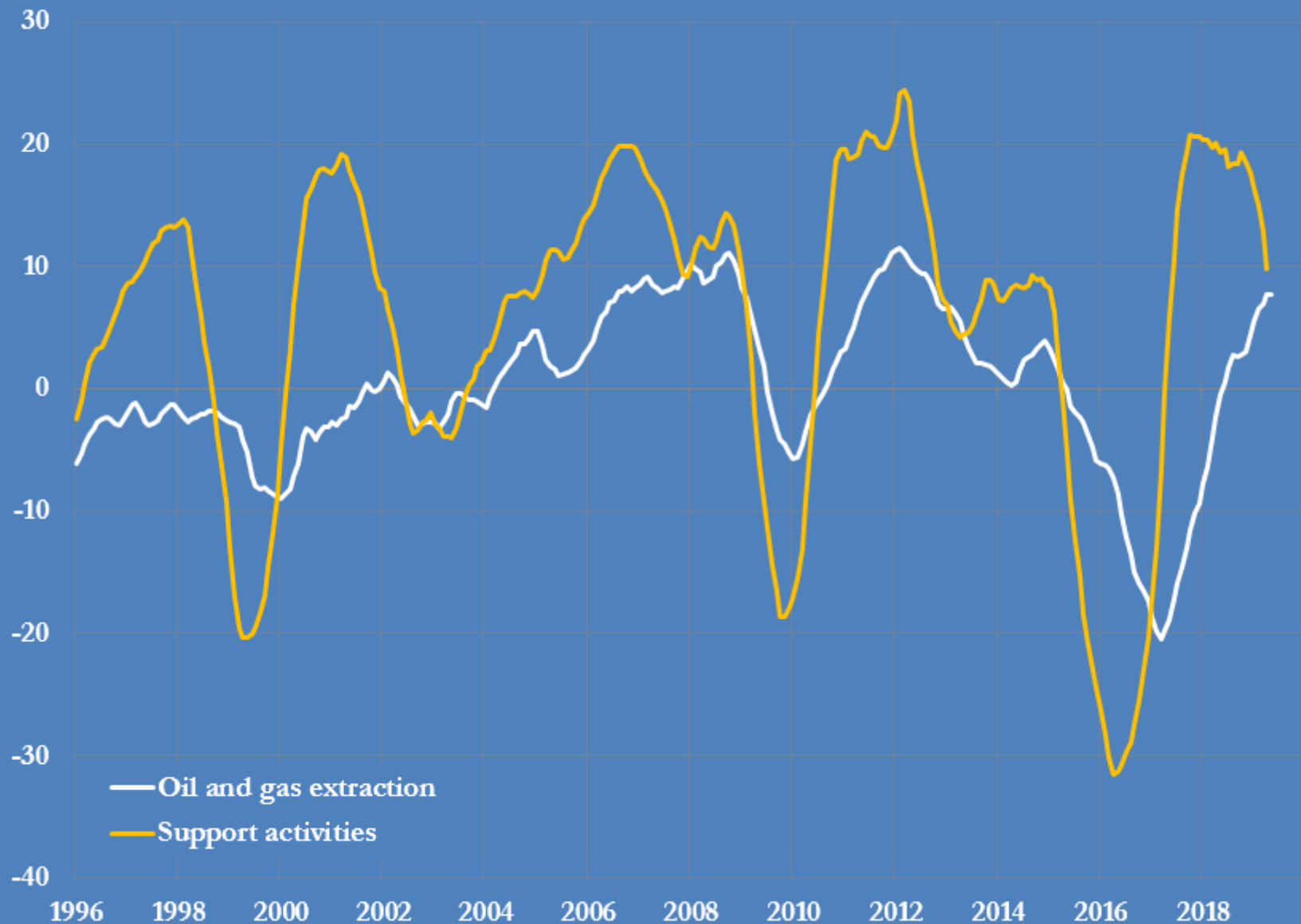
