

Dated Brent calendar spread from week 1 to week 6 U.S.\$ per barrel, contango (-) or backwardation (+)





Brent spot prices and calendar spreads, 2019-2020


Left-axis: front-month futures (percent change from two months prior)

Money managers' long and short positions in Brent futures and options contracts (million barrels) (ICE Brent)





Ratio of money managers' long to short positions in ICE Brent (semi-log scale)










Ratio of money managers' long to short positions in Brent percentiles 2013-2020
