

Reuters/Ipsos Poll: Perceptions on Race in America

These are some of the findings of an Ipsos poll conducted between July 16-22, 2019 on behalf of Thomson Reuters. For this survey, a sample of 4,436 adults age 18+ from the continental U.S., Alaska and Hawaii were interviewed online in English. The sample includes 3,879 registered voters, 1,821 Democratic registered voters, 1,551 Republican registered voters, and 378 Independent registered voters. Weighting was then employed to balance demographics to ensure that the sample's composition reflects that of the adult population according to Census data and to provide results intended to approximate the sample universe. The precision of Ipsos online polls is measured using a credibility interval. In this case, the poll is accurate to within ± 1.7 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, had all Americans been polled. The credibility interval will be wider among subsets of the population. All sample surveys and polls may be subject to other sources of error, including, but not limited to coverage error, and measurement error. The poll also has a credibility interval plus or minus 1.8 percentage points for registered voters, plus or minus 2.8 percentage points for Republican registered voters, plus or minus 5.7 percentage points for Independent registered voters
