





China real GDP and energy consumption, 1978-2018 Index 1978 = 100

China real GDP and energy consumption, 1978-2018 Index 1978 = 100, semi-logarithmic scale










China energy consumption and real GDP, 1990-2018 percent annual growth rates





China primary energy consumption, 1980-2019 Exajoules





China primary energy consumption, 1980-2019 selected sources, percent of total primary energy consumption





China coal production, 1896-2018 annual, million tonnes




China oil production, consumption and net imports, 1965-2019 million barrels per day, consumption and net imports shown negative
