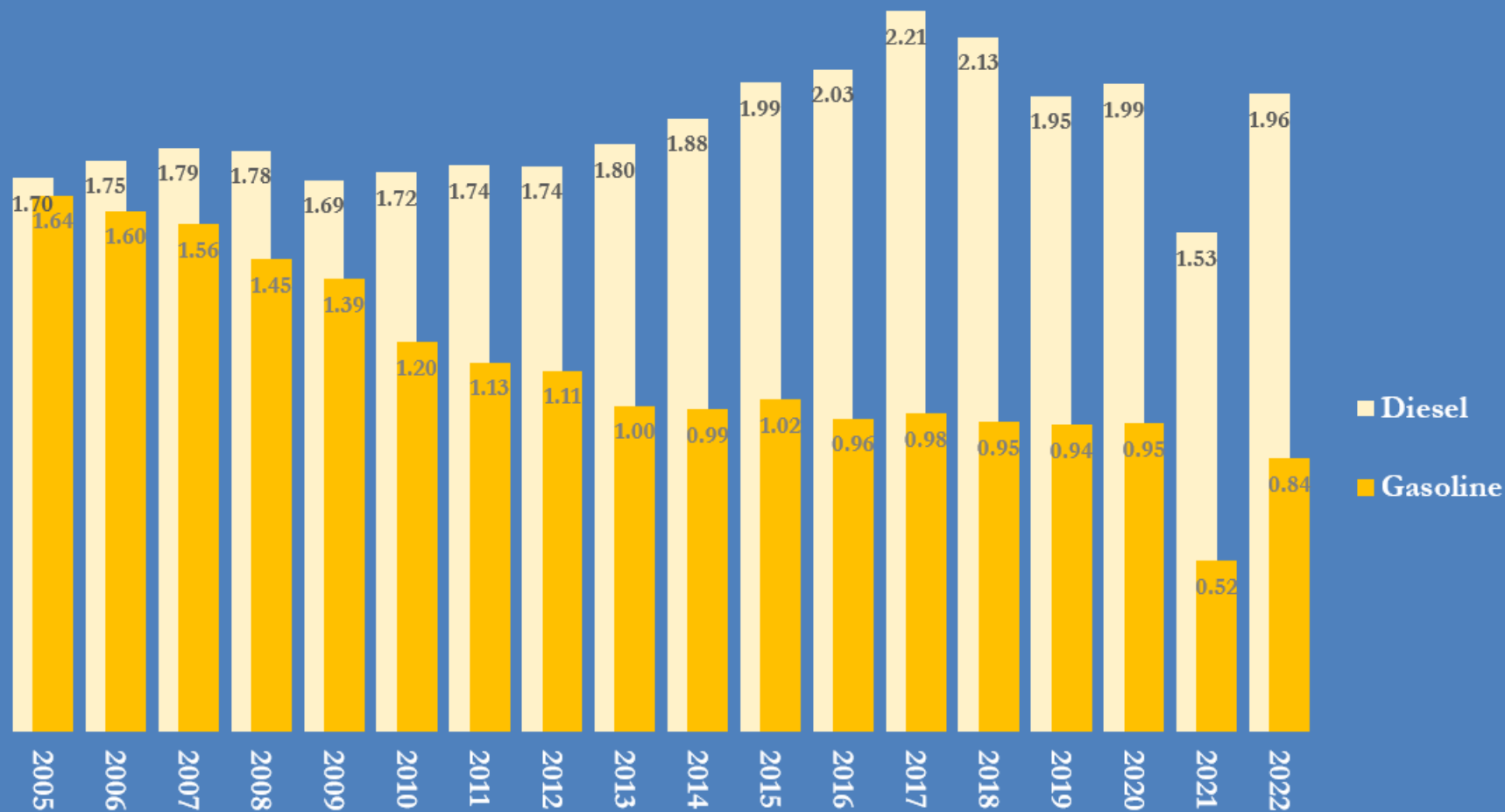

U.K. gasoline and diesel inland consumption, 2005-2022

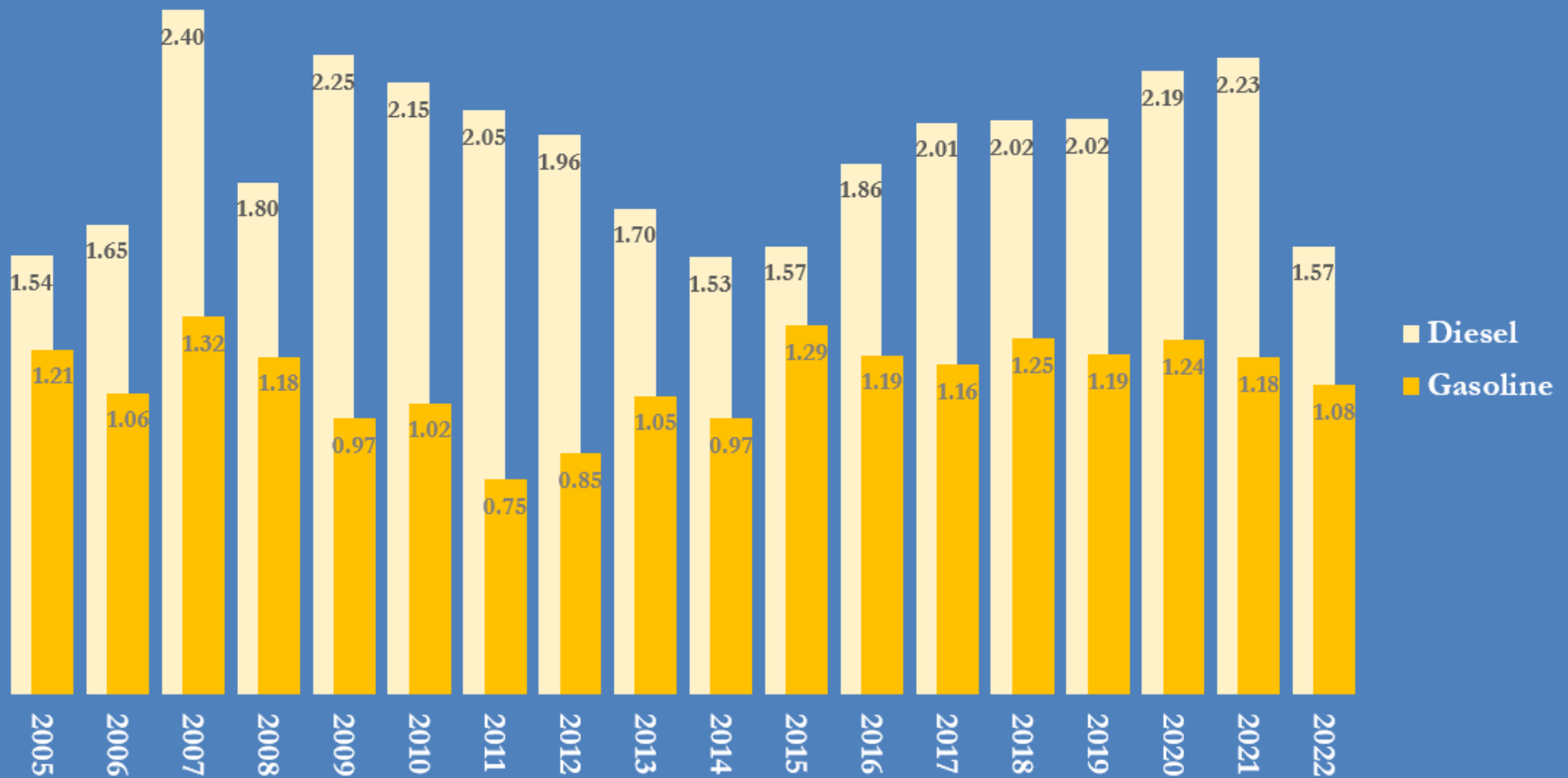

U.K. gasoline and diesel inventories, 2005-2022

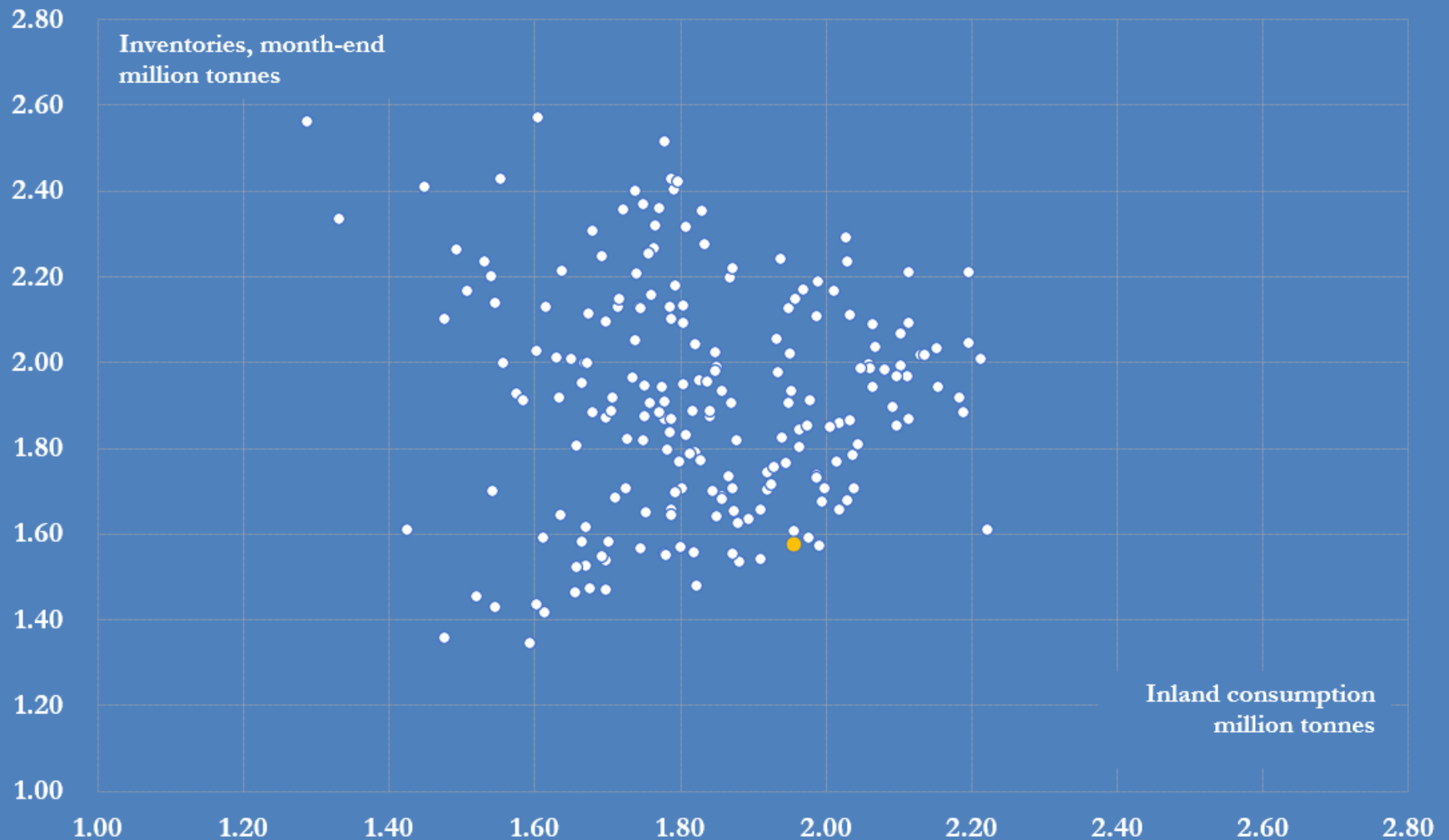
million tonnes, each year at end of February

U.K. diesel consumption and inventories, 2005-2022

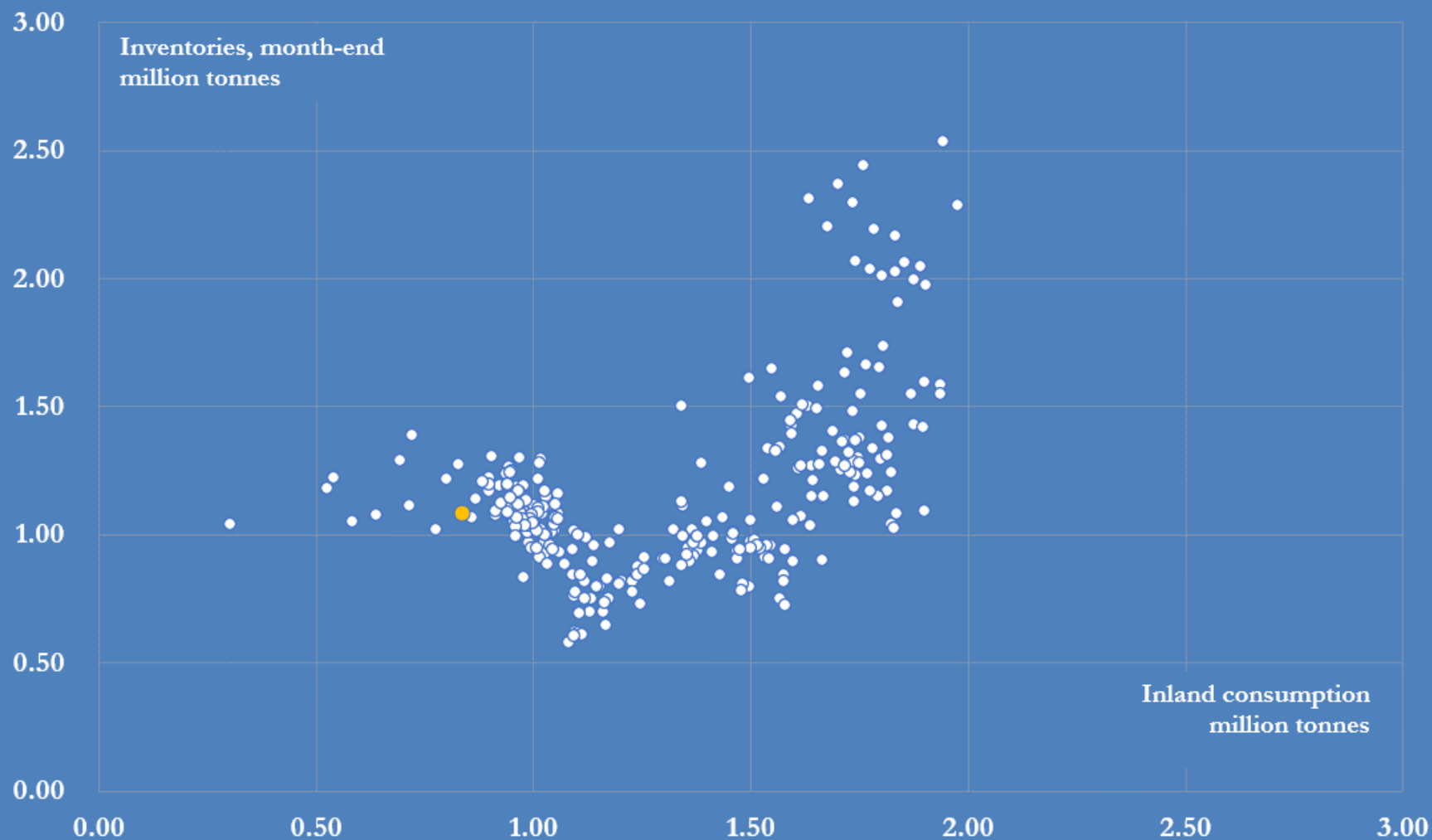
million tonnes, monthly

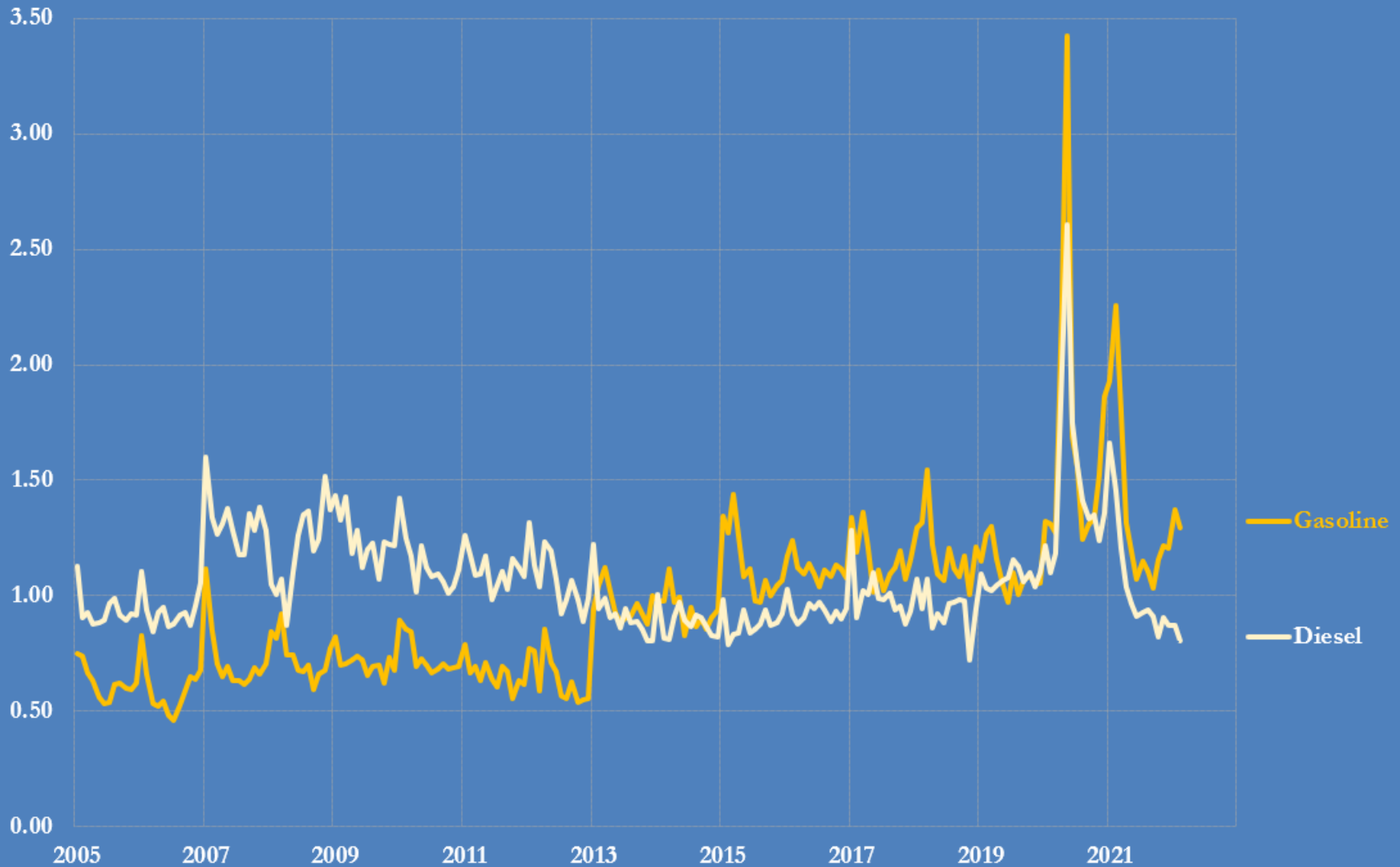
U.K. gasoline consumption and inventories, 2005-2022

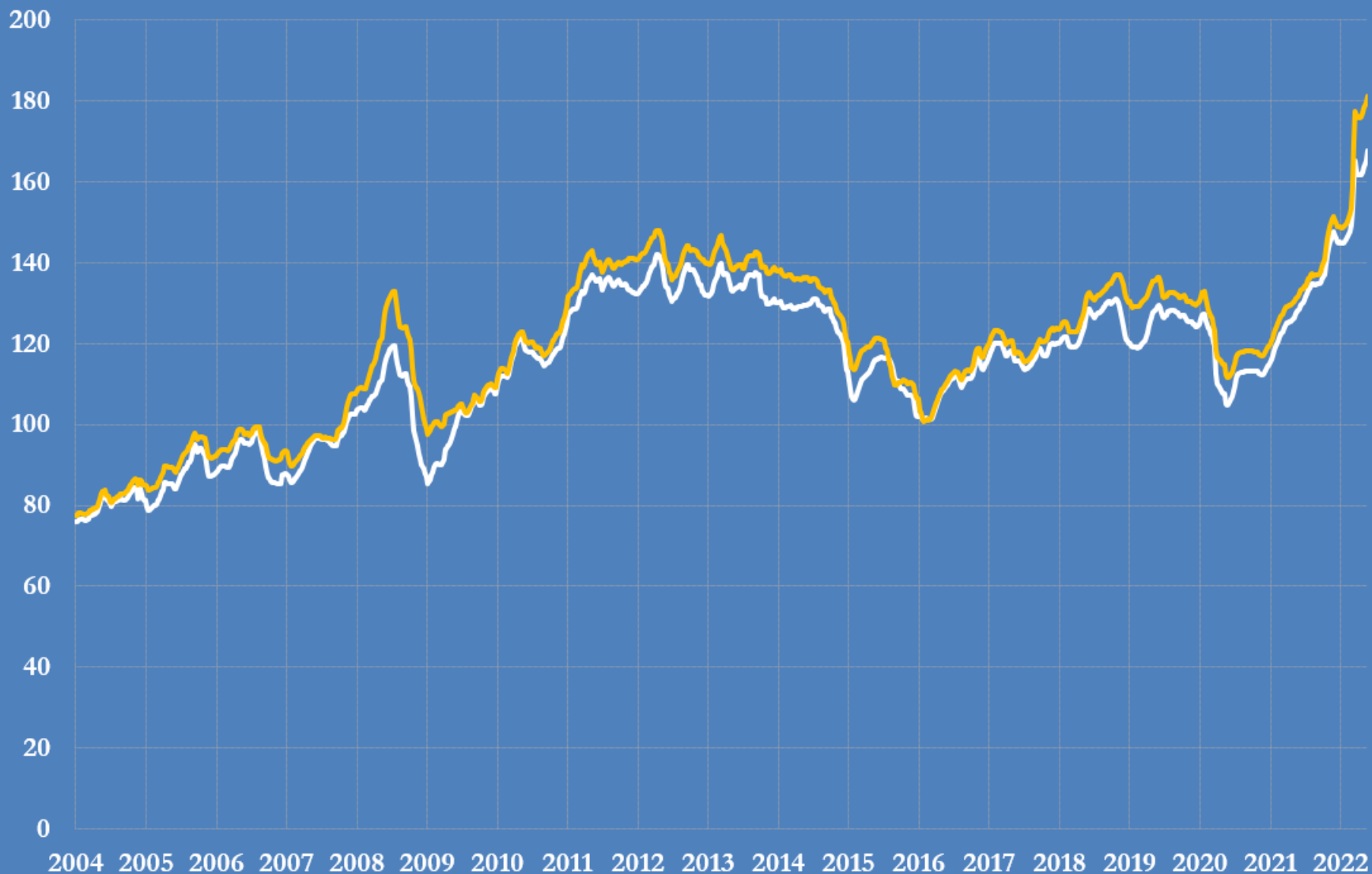
U.K. gasoline and diesel inventory-to-consumption ratios, 2005-2022 monthly

pence per litre, weekly, national average

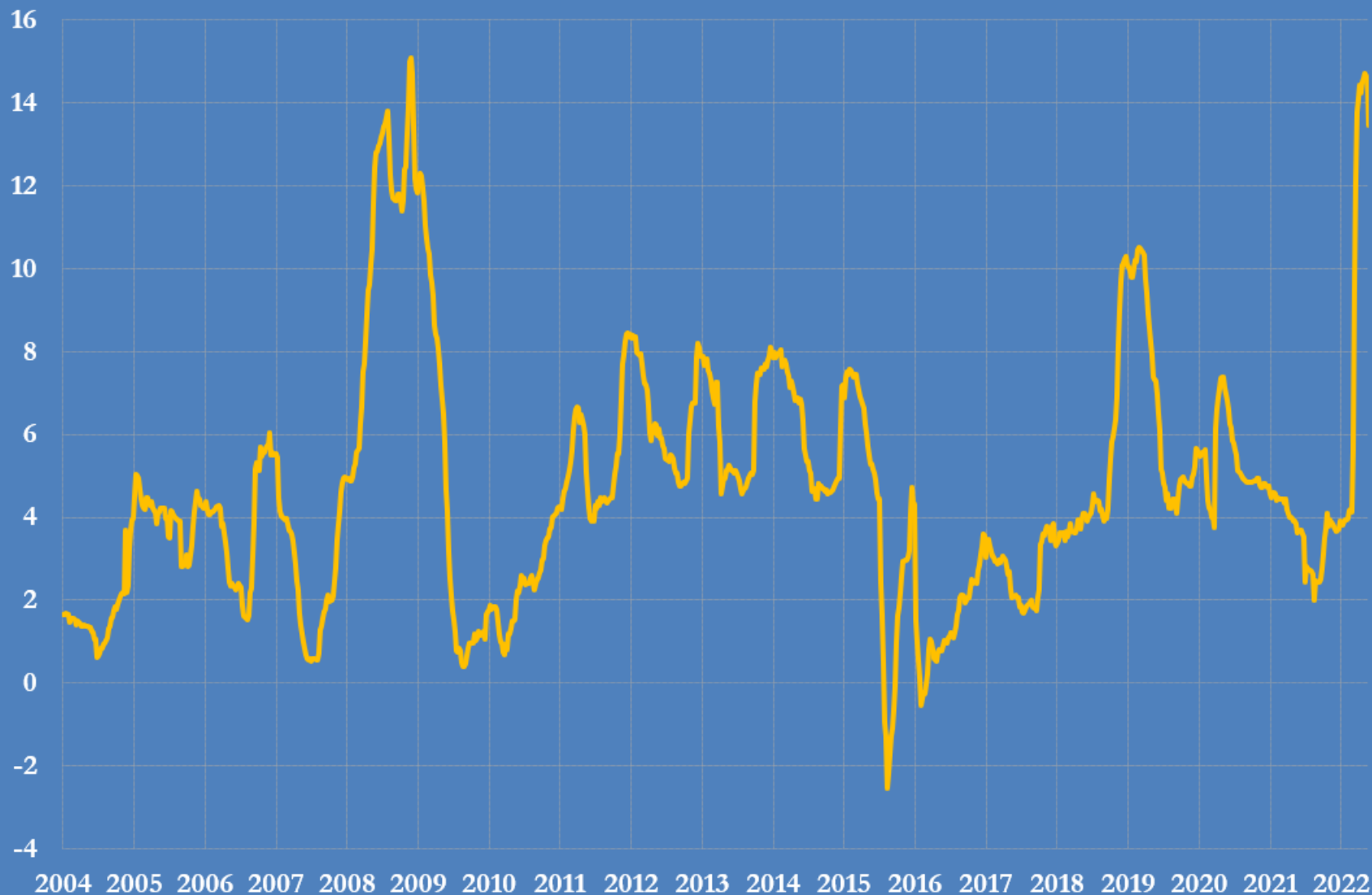
