



U.S. industrial energy consumption, 1990-2019 total from all sources, percent change from prior year, 3-month average




U.S. electricity supplied to industrial customers, 2000-2019 percent change from prior year, monthly and three-month average


U.S. industrial gas consumption, 2000-2019 percent change from prior year, three-month average

U.S. distillate fuel oil supplied to domestic market, 1990-2019 percent change from prior year, monthly and three-month average NBER recessions shown



R-axis: Distillate supplied (YoY % chg)




## Distillate fuel oil supplied to U.S. customers, 2000-2019 Percent change from prior year, three-month average








U.S. Purchasing Managers' Index, 1950-2019
