**PLAINTIFF STATES' SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION TO THE PANEL
CONCERNING GOOGLE'S MOTION FOR TRANSFER OF ACTIONS TO THE
NORTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA**

Pursuant to Panel Rule 6.1(f), counsel for Plaintiff State of Texas, Idaho, Mississippi, North Dakota, and South Dakota provides notice of supplemental information regarding the State Antitrust Enforcement Venue Act of 2021 (H.R. 3460, S. 1787). As explained in the Plaintiff States' Opposition to Google's Motion to Transfer, bipartisan legislation was introduced in the House of Representative on May 21, 2021, and in the Senate on May 24, 2021, to ensure enforcement actions brought by state attorneys general remain in their selected venues. On June 18, 2021, the National Association of Attorneys General sent a letter (attached as Exhibit A) to House and Senate leadership on behalf of 52 attorneys general advocating for "strong support" for passage of the legislation "as soon as possible." On June 24, 2021, the House Committee on the Judiciary approved H.R. 3460 by a margin of 34 to 7 and is expected to receive a full chamber vote by the House in the near future. See Roll Call Vote attached as Exhibit B. The Senate companion bill, S. 1787, is also expected to advance and may be considered by the Senate Judiciary Committee as early as July 29, 2021—the same date the Panel has scheduled a hearing in this matter. Plaintiff States will continue to monitor legislative developments concerning the State Antitrust Enforcement Venue Act of 2021 and apprise the Panel of its passage, which would render the pending motion to transfer moot as to Plaintiff States.
