



U.S. hurricanes and tropical storms, 1851-2021 distribution of landfall dates



U.S. hurricanes and tropical storms, 1851-2021 number of storms making landfall each year



U.S. refinery and blender net production of distillate fuel oil, 1981-2021 million bbl, production each year in three months from Aug to Oct



U.S. refinery and blender net production of distillate fuel oil, 1981-2021 million bbl, change from prior year, output from Aug to Oct



U.S. distillate fuel oil inventories, 2007-2022 million barrels, each year on May 20






U.S. distillate fuel oil stocks, 2007-2022 million barrels, annual trajectory, current year highlighted
