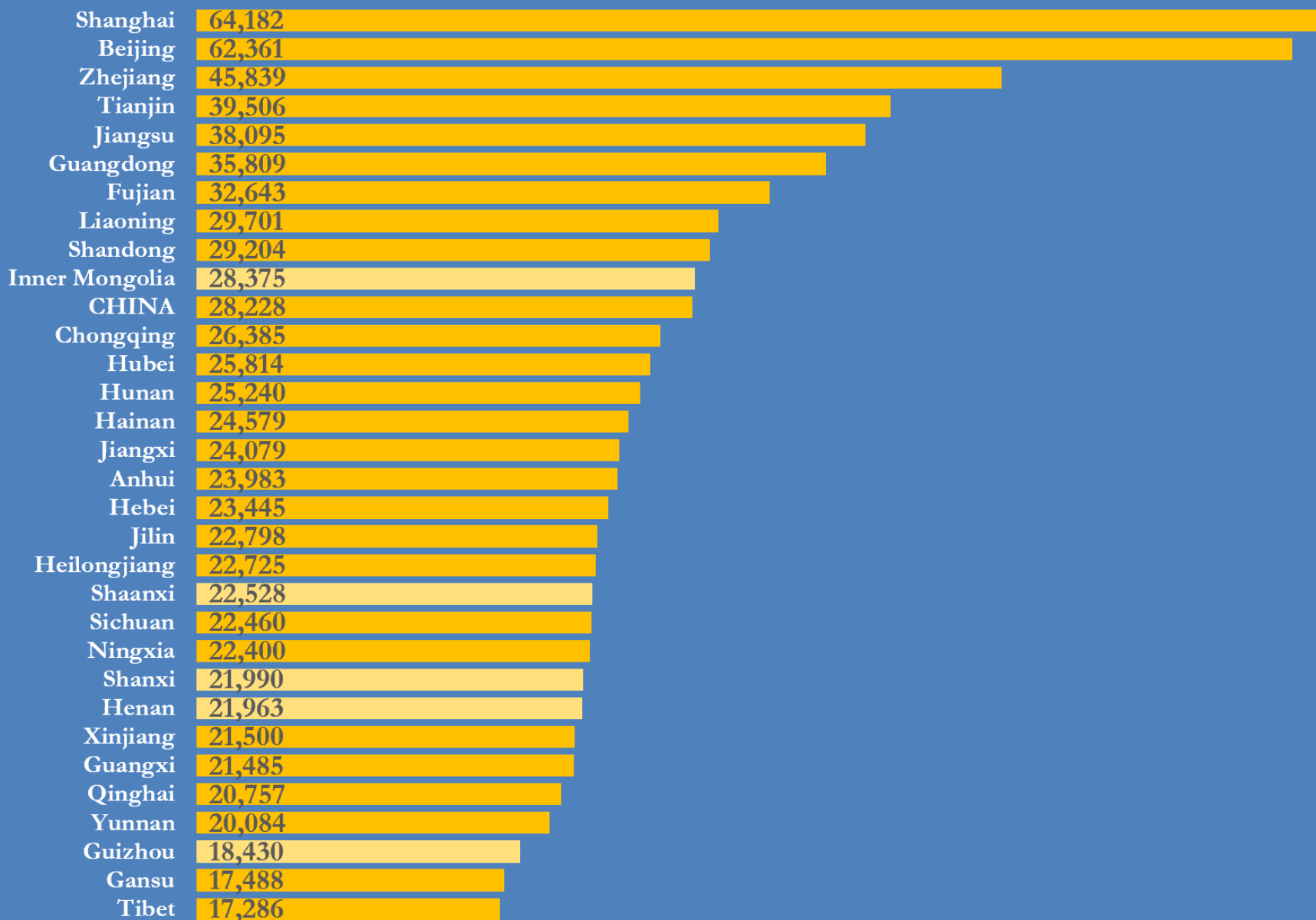

yuan, provinces and provincial-level cities



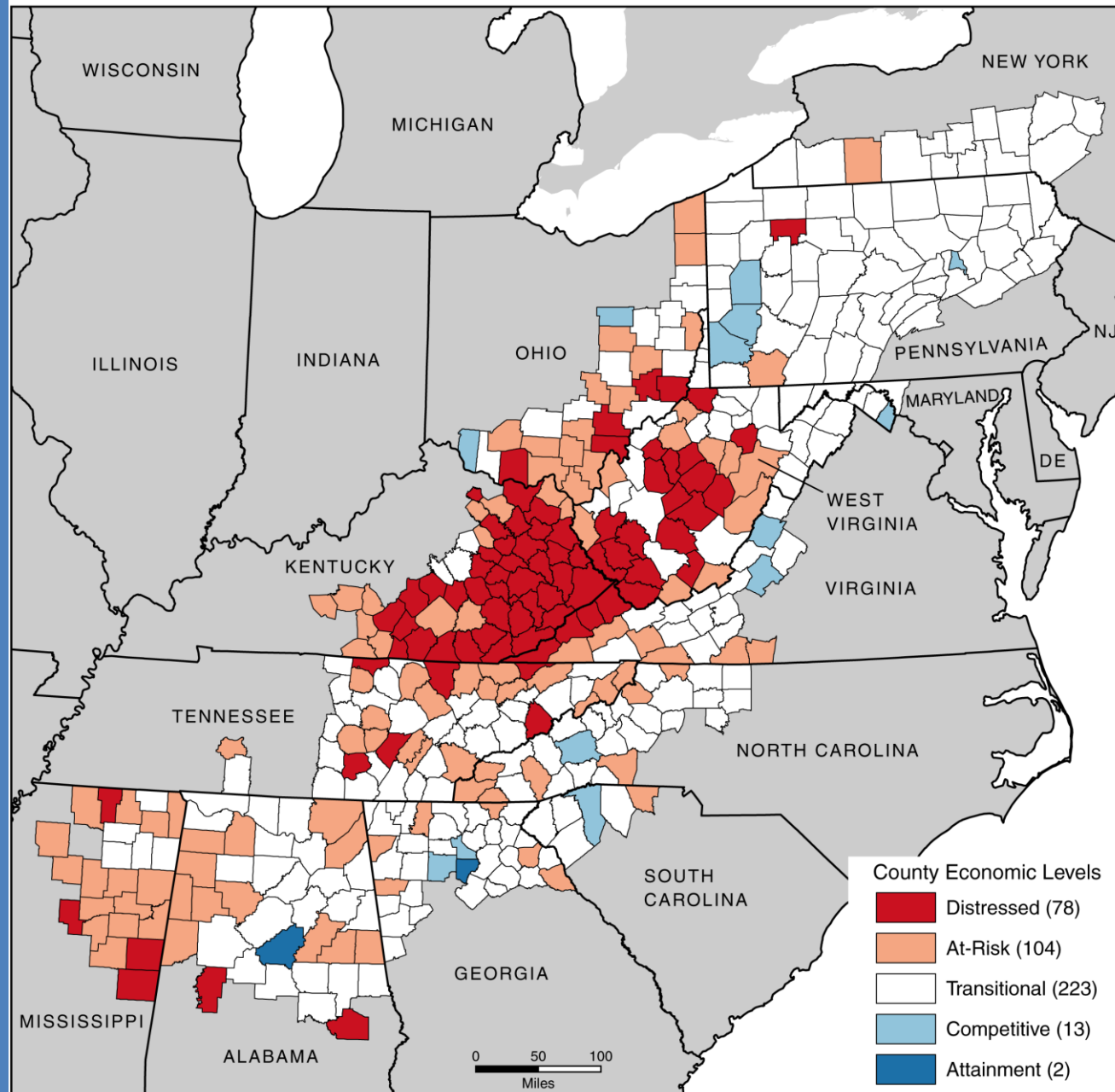
China coal production and household incomes by province

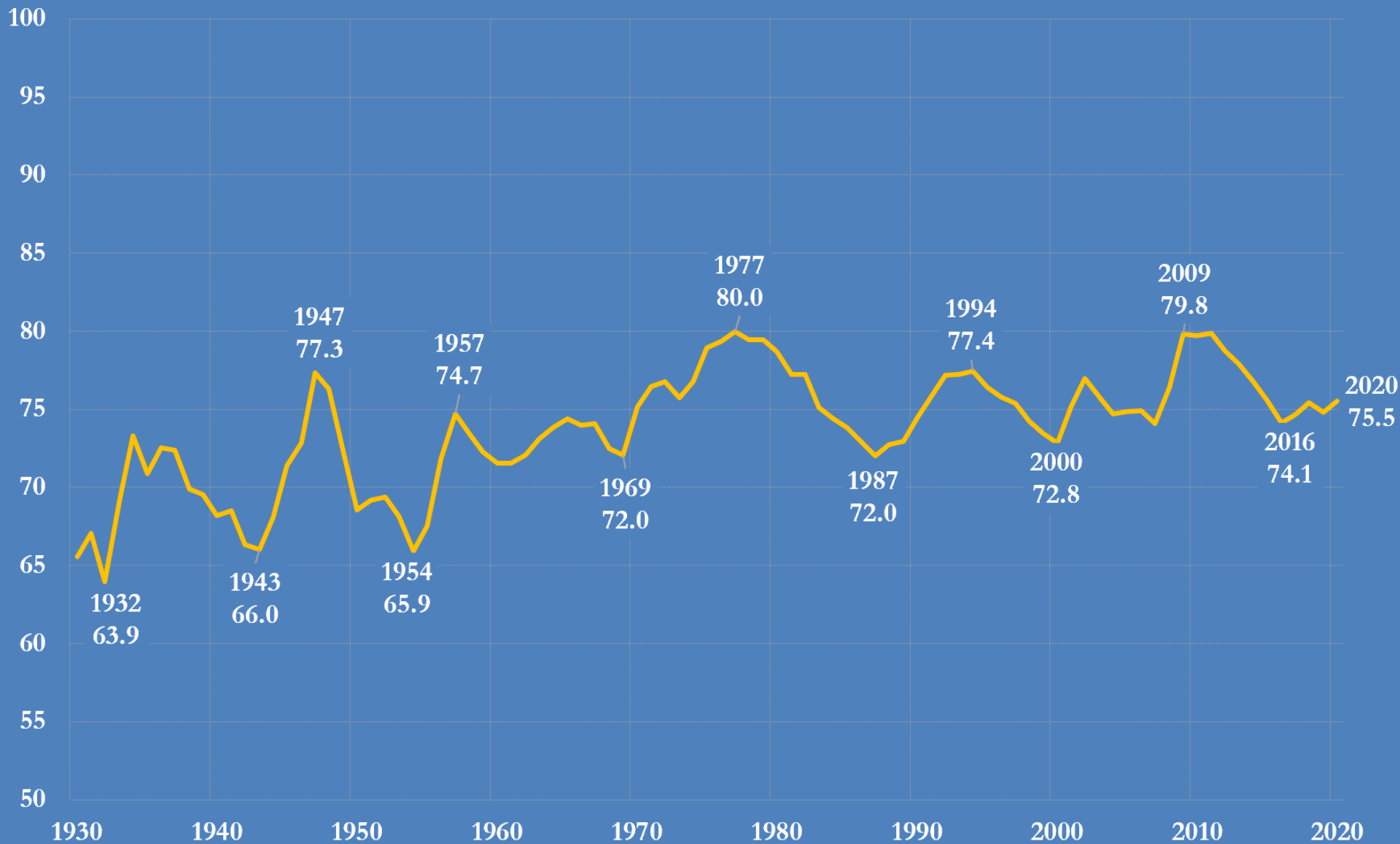

West Virginia per capita income as percent of U.S. average annual, 1930-2020

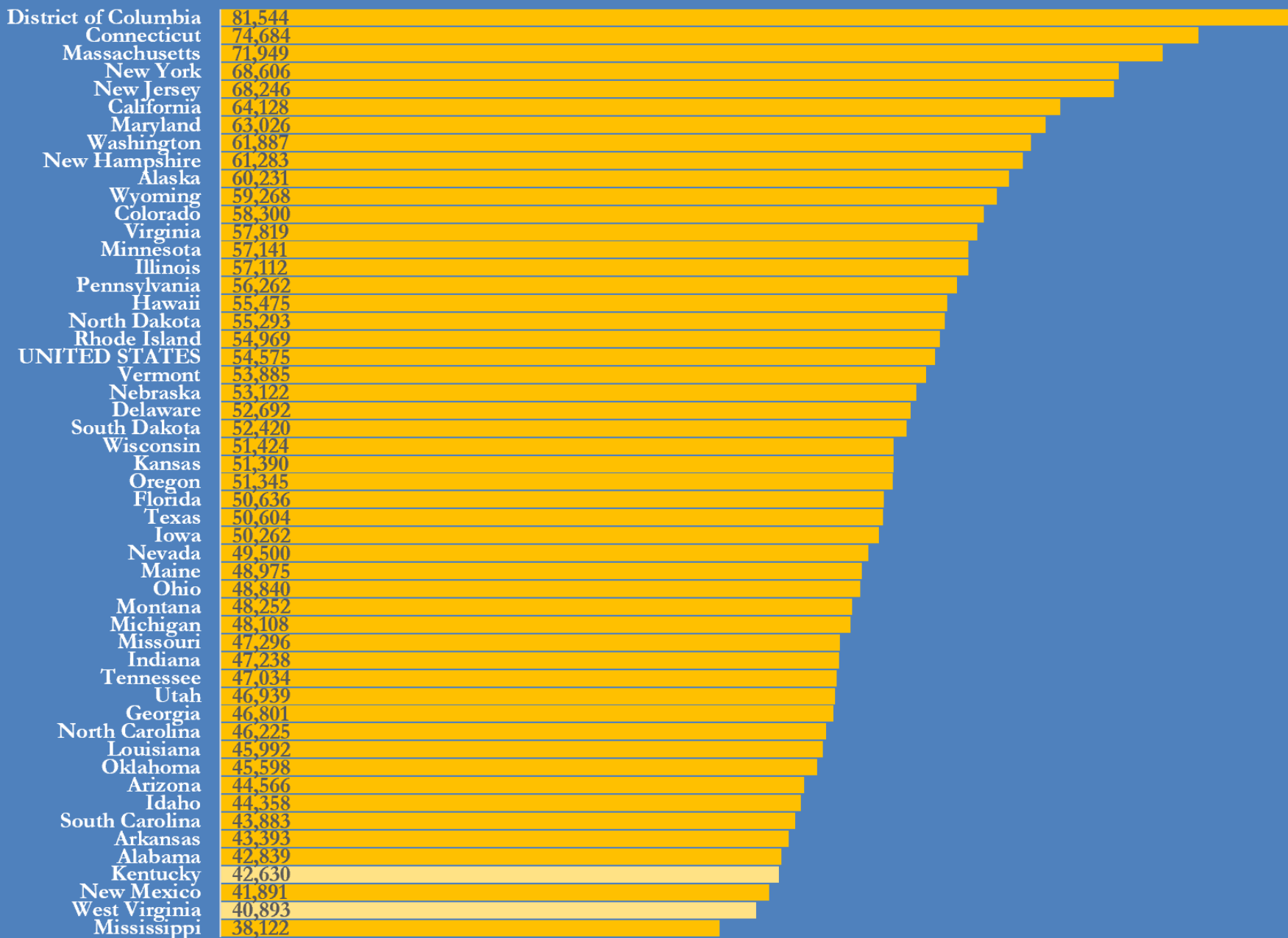

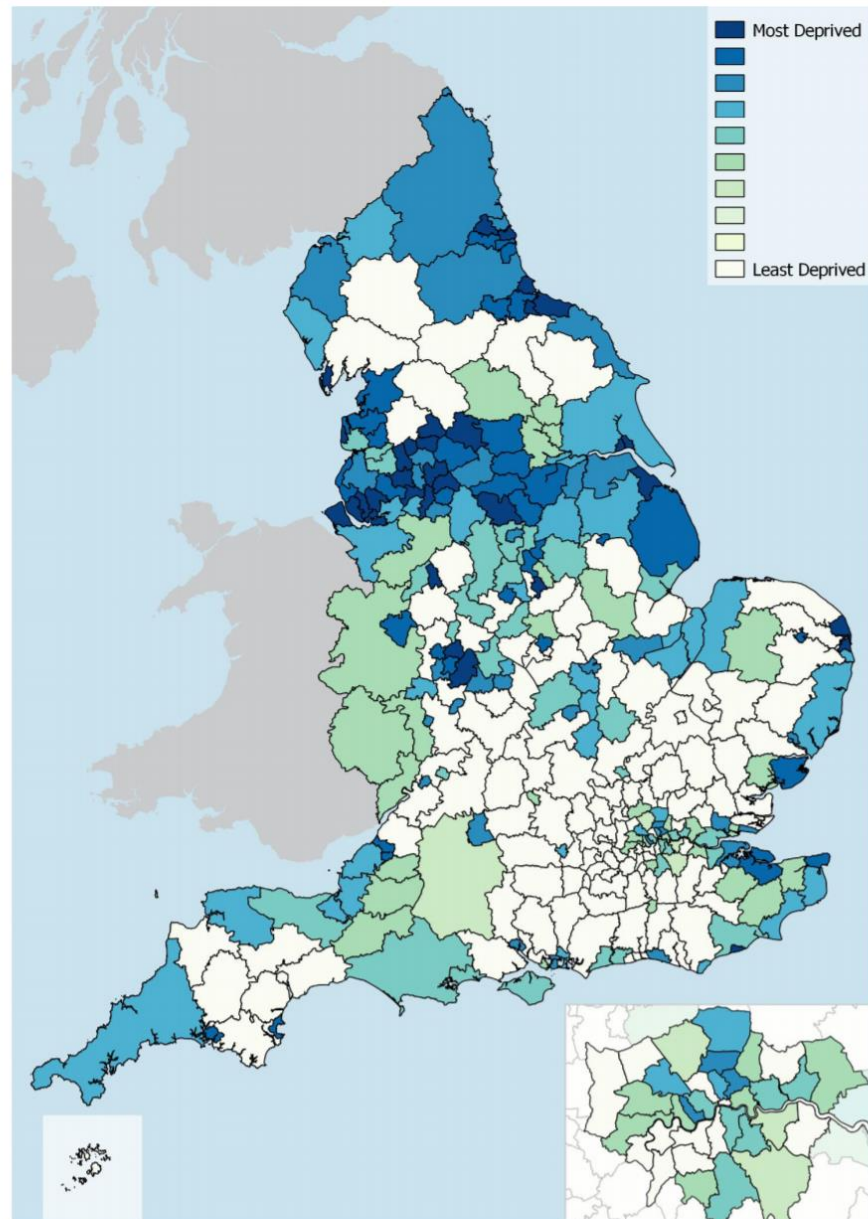
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U.S. personal income per capita, 2020
