

Money managers' weekly net position change in middle distillates European gas oil plus U.S. diesel (million bbl)





Money managers' Brent and WTI positions, 2013-2022 weekly, net position, million barrels




Total open interest in six major petroleum futures contracts NYMEX and ICE WTI, ICE Brent, U.S. gasoline, U.S. diesel, European gas oil
