

## Money managers' combined net position in Brent, WTI, U.S. gasoline, U.S. diesel and European gas oil million barrels, weekly





Money managers' total long and short positions in Brent, WTI, U.S. gasoline, U.S. heating oil and European gasoil (million bbl)




## Money managers' weekly net position change in Brent, WTI, U.S. gasoline, U.S. heating oil and Euro gasoil (million bbl)
